DAY 2 HAVANA

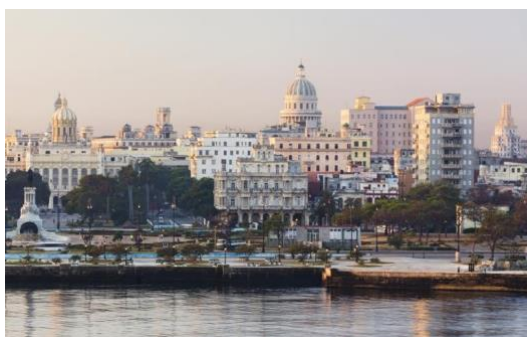
9 -10 AM Breakfast at casa

Evening: Dinner

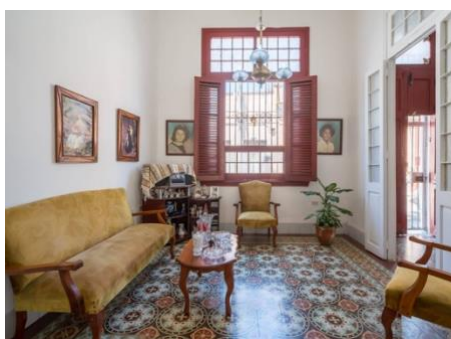
